Dear Family/Whānau,

We would like all children to start the school year with their new stationery, covered and named, on the first day of term so we can establish routines and start working in books from day one. This year we are asking that all books be NAMED ONLY. Subject titles will be done in class during the first week of school as teachers will set books up with A1 standards in the first week.

We would like all books to be covered with a book cover or duraseal as this helps to keep them in good condition and encourages your children to do 'The Best I Can Do' in their learning. We promote the use of clear duraseal as it is far cheaper than patterned versions. EZ covers are also suitable if you prefer these. <https://www.ezcovers.com/nz/>

We have tried very hard to keep stationery costs to a minimum for you. If your children already have pens, rulers, colouring pencils etc, PLEASE RE-USE as many of these general stationery items as you can, however, students will need to start the year with new books so expectations around presentation in each classroom can be set at the beginning of the year. Please label your child's stationery - this gets lost or 'stolen' very quickly otherwise.


