**This position is within Kupe Team (Year 4-8) starting in Term 2, 2023. The successful applicant will be teaching either in our senior hub (Years 6-8) or our Year 5/6 classroom depending on other staff appointments being made for Term 2 (we are currently in the process of appointing a new Deputy Principal). Beginning teachers are welcome to apply.**

We are a well-resourced 7 classroom rural school approximately 12 kilometres south-west of Dannevirke. We have a culture of **inclusiveness, high expectations of staff and students, and collaboration** focused around our ROCKERS values. The community has a long history of actively supporting our school and taking interest in their children's education at Ruahine School. We are very proud of our school and the achievements of our tamariki through the broad curriculum and wide range of learning activities our skilled kaiako provide. We are well-resourced and are lucky to have an astroturf, indoor heated pool and QEII bush reserve.

**Our most valuable assets are our teachers and support staff, and we have a strong culture of collaboration.** Our Board of Trustees budgets annually to provide additional classroom release time so that both our teams (Kupe and Pounamu) can meet four times a term for half a day for professional learning communities (PLCs). Our Board of Trustees also budgets generously for learning support and teacher aides.
