

# Ruahine School Stationery List 2023



Dear Family/Whānau,

We would like all children to start the school year with their new stationery on the **first day of term** so we can establish routines and start working in books from day one.

We would like all books to be covered with a book cover or duraseal as this helps to keep them in good condition and encourages your children to do 'The Best I Can Do' in their learning. Books that are not covered often fall apart. We promote the use of clear duraseal as it is far cheaper than patterned versions. EZ covers are also suitable if you prefer these: <https://www.ezcovers.com/nz/> You are welcomed to use patterned duraseal.

We have tried very hard to keep stationery costs to a minimum for you. If your children already have pens, rulers, colouring pencils etc, PLEASE RE-USE as many of these general stationery items as you can, however, students will need to start the year with new books so expectations around presentation in each classroom can be set at the beginning of the year. **If you are going to struggle financially to supply stationery for your child/ren, please let Ali know in the office so that we can help (office@ruahine.school.nz).**

Please label your child's stationery. There are lots of stationery items in the classroom and stationery can get easily lost or accidentally taken by others if they are not labelled.
